

Personal Income Tax Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

On November 3, 2020, Multnomah County voters approved a measure to establish a tuition-free preschool program. This program is funded by a personal income tax on residents of Multnomah County, which went into effect January 1, 2021. **Residents of Multnomah County will have 100% of their Oregon taxable income subject to the tax thresholds.**

The Preschool For All program is funded by a personal income tax of 1.5% on taxable income over \$125,000 for individuals and \$200,000 for joint filers, and an additional 1.5% on taxable income over \$250,000 for individuals and \$400,000 for joint filers. This rate will increase by 0.8% in 2026.

- Q. If I don't live in Multnomah County, am I subject to the Multnomah County Preschool For All Personal Income Tax?
 - A. No.
- Q. If I live in Multnomah County, how much of my Oregon Taxable Income is subject to the tax?
 - **A.** Multnomah County residents will have 100% of their Oregon Taxable Income subject to the tax thresholds. This may be an important factor in your decision to voluntarily request that the College withhold this tax on your behalf.
 - The College will not automatically withhold this tax.
- Q. I am a resident of Multnomah County. How do I opt-in for withholding for the Multnomah County Preschool for All Personal Income Tax?
 - **A.** To opt-in to withholdings, complete the Metro/Multnomah County Tax Opt Form in Neogov eForms.
- Q. How do I stop having the Multnomah County Preschool for All Personal Income Tax withheld from my paycheck?
 - **A.** If you opt-in, withholding will continue until you notify the College by completing an updated form indication you wish to stop voluntarily withholding the tax.
 - To stop having the Multnomah County Preschool for All Personal Income Tax withheld from my paycheck, complete the Metro/Multnomah County Tax Opt Form in Neogov eForms.
